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## Infant Frenectomy- What to Expect

**Before Visit** 

- 1. Fill out **NEW PATIENT** forms and bring with you to your appointment, or arrive 10 minutes early for paperwork.
- 2. Please plan childcare for other children so you can focus solely on your infant.
- 3. Ask questions *prior* to your appointment regarding fees and insurance.



- 1. We will bring you to our private consultation room. Our assistant will review your symptoms and chief complaint.
- 2. Dr. Olson will perform an oral exam and discuss whether treatment is indicated. There is ample time to answer any questions you may have.
- 3. Post treatment stretching exercises will be demonstrated.
- 4. You may choose to proceed with treatment the same day, time permitting.
- 5. Due to Laser Safety Guidelines *only necessary trained personnel are allowed in the laser operatory*; your child will be away from you for about 5 minutes in the presence of the doctor and assistants.
- 6. If you choose we can provide you with Sucrose which can help calm your baby. Laser eye shields are used on your child during the procedure. A cotton infant swaddle will be used to help limit your child's movement.
- 7. We ask that you nurse/feed in our consultation room immediately following the procedure.

## After Visit

- 1. Expect baby to be a little fussy for a day or two. Your baby may salivate more than usual. If needed, over the counter pain management may be used per your pediatricians recommendations.
- 2. **Follow up with your lactation consultant** and other services your baby may benefit from; your breast feeding technique may require alteration since your baby has less tethered oral tissue. Follow up services with other providers my include chiropractic or craniosacral therapy.
- 3. Start stretching exercises the day after procedure. **3x per day for 3 weeks.**
- 4. Schedule a 1 week follow up with our office. We will examine healing sites and ensure stretching exercises are being done properly.
